Spring Field Trips:

Mystic Seaport & Planetarium. Mrs. Connery presented to the PTO a field trip for the 3-6 graders. We opted for a guided tour rather than a self-guided tour and Mrs. Connery suggested that the teachers visit the website for Common core curriculum/language to choose an add-on program. The 3rd and 4th grade teachers will choose a program together and the 5th and 6th grade teachers will choose a program together. The teachers will provide their program choice to Mrs. Connery.
